Professor Jonas Pranas Aleksa (1879-1955) was one of the most famous leaders of the agrarian sector in the independent Lithuania (1920-1940) and the founder of the agrarian economy science. J. P. Aleksa's public and scientific activities were effectively adapted for the strengthening of democracy in the state public administration and the creation of modern rural development strategy. Also, the J. P. Aleksa personality itself becomes is a bright example for future generations, how to serve to the native country and to the universal goodness. This year we remember his 146th birth and 70th death anniversaries.
